The SRP and SRM Half-Day Seminar will introduce participants to the history, concepts and functionality of the SRP and SRM and how to implement the programs in their organizations.

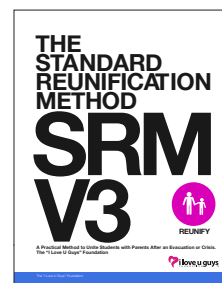

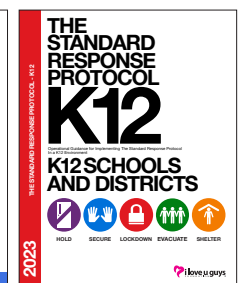
